"This collection easily adapts to any style of interior design" says Sestig, who relied on the basic form of his "Pleasure Dôme" for the creation of this brand new line for valerie_objects. "This form permits the elegant stacking of the bowls, where every base forms the lid of the lower one."

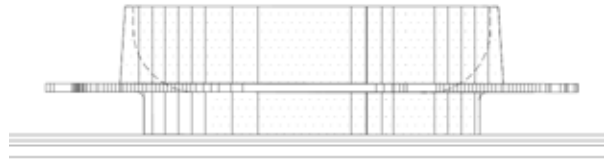
For the name 'Dishes to Dishes', Sestig was inspired by none other than David Bowie. "When I heard the song 'Ashes to Ashes' in the car, the name 'Dishes to Dishes' came to mind. All the more so because I think the low basic form of the dishes is reminiscent of a galactic shape and I heard the text 'I'm Happy, hope you're happy too'. These are the words that Major Tom sends out of space to Ground Control."

In a first phase, the Dishes to Dishes dishes will appear in two materials: tinted wood and coloured ceramics. Tactile and rich materials that are suitable for use in the kitchen. Later this year, coloured glass and oven dishes in cast iron will follow.

— glenn sestig

Glenn Sestig, born in 1968 in Ghent, Belgium, graduated from the Henri Van De Velde institute in Antwerp and in 1999 established his practice. From the outset, his work focused on extreme precision, on a construction with such mastery of the architectural line, proportions and perspective that it is easy to forget the careful consideration that will have gone into his design and creation. In addition to the material and its interpretation, transparency and the play of reflection suggest rather than illustrate the endeavours that have resulted in the real grandeur of some projects, primarily places for public use.

Glenn Sestig Architects is synonymous with contemporary elegance. Their work can be seen as monolithic and intuitive but always with a strong refined architectural identity. The cohesion or even clash between different exclusive and unique materials elevates this identity. Therefore the architect uses his own method of calculation, a sort of mental model from which flow the intelligence, equilibrium and soul of a place. Each completed work is considered as a minor work of art wherein art, fashion and music are essential sources of inspiration. The architecture is no longer a movement in time but becomes a declaration of a clear architectural vocabulary.

With regular publications in renowned magazines and recognition in global architectural awards Glenn Sestig has earned his place as one of the most noticeable architects out there.

Early commissions included shops, nightclubs and penthouses spread across different cities in Belgium, but over the last couple of years the projects grew in size ranging from brand display unit for Kvadrat/Raf Simons, a new residence with studio for Soulwax/2manydjs to even a flagship store for Hieronymus in Zurich - Switzerland. Thanks to some magnificent projects with great exposure Glenn Sestig received international recognition with projects from Tokyo to Los Angeles.

valerie_objects is an Antwerp-based design label initiated by Axel Van Den Bossche and art director Veerle Wenes, combining their professional and personal taste for all things good and beautiful.

By allowing designers, architects and artists to translate their signature style into tangible objects, valerie_objects has become a unique collection of everyday items with out-of-the-box aesthetics. These are objects people truly get entangled with.
